The Paralympic Games are an athletic competition for people who are disabled. The name is short for parallel Olympic because they take part at the same time as the Olympic Games.

Wheelchair sports began in a hospital in England in 1948. They were started by a doctor who felt that sports should be part of the process of getting better. The Paralympic Games were born in Rome in 1960, where there were 400 athletes from 23 different countries. Forty years later, at the Sydney 2000 Games, in Australia there were about 4000 athletes from 125 countries.

One of the most popular sports is the wheelchair basketball which has been part of the Paralympic since the beginning.
